Please note that there is no rental car company on Ama Town, Nakanoshima Island. You can rent a car from another Dozen Islands than bring the car to Ama Town on the car-loading Inter-Islander called Ferry Dozen. The ferry fare to load the car costs 1,000 yen per ride.

Driving in Japan

Renting a car is an option worth considering if you plan to explore rural Japan (Oki Islands) where public [transportation](#) can be both inconvenient and infrequent.

A rental car can also be an [economical](#) alternative when traveling in groups or can make traveling with a lot of luggage easier.

The minimum age for driving in Japan is 18 years, and you will need a [Japanese driver's license](#) or an International Driving Permit (IDP) in order to rent and drive a car.
